Item #1. Call to Order

The Board of Trustees of the Gonzales Independent School District met Monday, July 11, 2022, at the Administrative Office Board Room, Gonzales, Texas. President, Ross Hendershot, III called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

A quorum was declared with 7 members present.

Invocation, Pledge, Mission Statement

Sue Gottwald gave the Invocation, Glenn Menking led the Pledge to the Flag, and Sandra Gorden read the Mission Statement.

B. <u>Discuss and Consider Action to Approve the 2022-23 District Compensation Plan Additions and Changes</u>

It was explained that in accordance with policy code DEA, the administration brings the recommended changes and additions to the 2022-23 Compensation Plan. The final compensation plan includes extra duty, substitute, supplemental pay, and revisions for review and approval by the Board.

Ms. Haley Ratliff, Chief HR Officer, requested approval of the Teacher Appraisal Calendar for the 2022-23 school year. Ms. Ratliff informed the board that according to GISD policy DNA (legal), the board is required to annually adopt a calendar that designates dates for teacher observation used for the teacher appraisal process. The calendar included dates when formal teacher observations are not permitted under this policy.

Gloria Torres made a motion, with a second from Justin Schwausch, to approve the adoption of the 2022-2023 Teacher Appraisal Calendar, As presented. The motion carried 7/0

D. <u>Discuss and Consider Action to Approve an Interlocal Agreement with Waelder Independent School District for Transportation Services</u>

Gene Kridler explained to the board the interlocal agreement with WISD which was for the DAEP transportation services.
